Ecological Engineers accept the responsibility engineering involves to create regenerative landscapes as the common household basis of human society and natural ecosystems. They design systems that provide useful goods and services for the human society while retaining their functionality as ecosystems.

Fields of practice

A major focus of Ecological Engineers is sustainable water management, especially the design of wastewater recycling and ecological sanitation systems, constructed wetlands and aquacultures as well as natural wetland and river restoration. Other active fields are, e.g.,:

- Renewable energy
- Transportation, infrastructure
- Process engineering
- Landscape architecture
- Permaculture, agroengineering
- Sustainable architecture

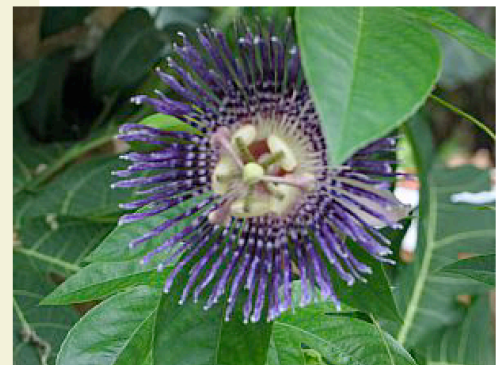
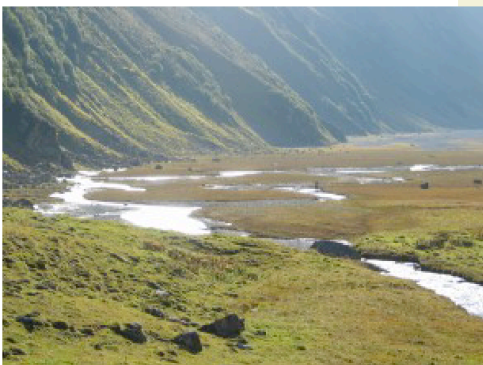
