The number of participants is limited to 20, therefore a timely registration and prepayment is required until 8th September 2006. After that deadline participation is only possible upon request. Below a minimum of 12 participants the oragnizer reserves the right to cancel the tour.

Study tour fees per person:

The complete package price for the study tour is 1290 Euro, it includes:

- 6x standard accommodation in double rooms (single rooms have to be booked seperately at 240 Euro extra charge),
