Guidelines for authors

The EcoEng-Newsletter (further on called "newsletter") is an all-electronic periodical published by IEES for members and for people interested in Ecological Engineering. The newsletter is published once or twice per year on <http://www.iees.ch>. There are no paper copies distributed.

The newsletter is rather a community platform, where Ecological Engineers share their work with other colleagues, than a full fledged journal. We don't have an extensive review procedure. All articles are briefly reviewed on relevance for the community and on language by the editorial board.

Our readers and contributors are from all over the world. Only a fraction of them speaks English as mother tongue. The academic fields or readers come from are also quite diverse, ranging from engineering over natural sciences to social sciences and economics.

For writing an article, please obey the following guidelines:

- Choose a good, catchy title and a subtitle that explains the content
- Please use plain, simple, colloquial English without too many technical terms
- Wherever technical terms can't be avoided, please explain them
- Please write the article with Microsoft Word, if possible
- Include 1-2 photos that illustrate your article, preferably in .GIF or .JPG format (size is not important, will be edited by us)
- Include a short biographical text about yourself (5-10 lines at most)
- Include a photo of yourself, preferably in .GIF or .JPG format
- The length should not exceed the equivalent of 2-3 A4 pages
- Mail the article, the photos and the biographical note altogether to editor@iees.ch
- Don't worry too much about layouting. All layouting will be done by the editorial board.
